 - Provides screenings to determine eligibility for housing programs in the community for households who are homeless or at risk of homelessness
 - Programs include:
 - Shelter + Care - permanent housing program for homeless individuals with serious mental illness
 - CHG Rental assistance to rapidly re-house individuals and families that are at imminent risk or currently experiencing literal homelessness
 - Mental Health Housing Program
 - SUD Housing Program
 - Jail Release Housing Program
 - Disabled Housing Program
 - Veterans Relief Fund

- Programs include: (must be referred from Housing Resource Center)
 - Bateman and Choices - Permanent Supportive Housing Program for chronically homeless individuals with disabilities
 - Young Adult Housing Program (18-24) – short & medium-term rental assistance
 - Tenant Based Rental Assistance - Transitional Housing Rental Assistance (up to 2 years) for families with children
 - HOPWA – Housing assistance for those living (& their families) with HIV/AIDS
 - Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) - Rent assistance, utility assistance, transportation, & essential needs (determination by DSHS)
 - EFH/TANF - Rental Assistance for families
 - CHG - Rental assistance (deposit, short-term, utility, application fees and transportation) to rapidly re-house individuals and families
